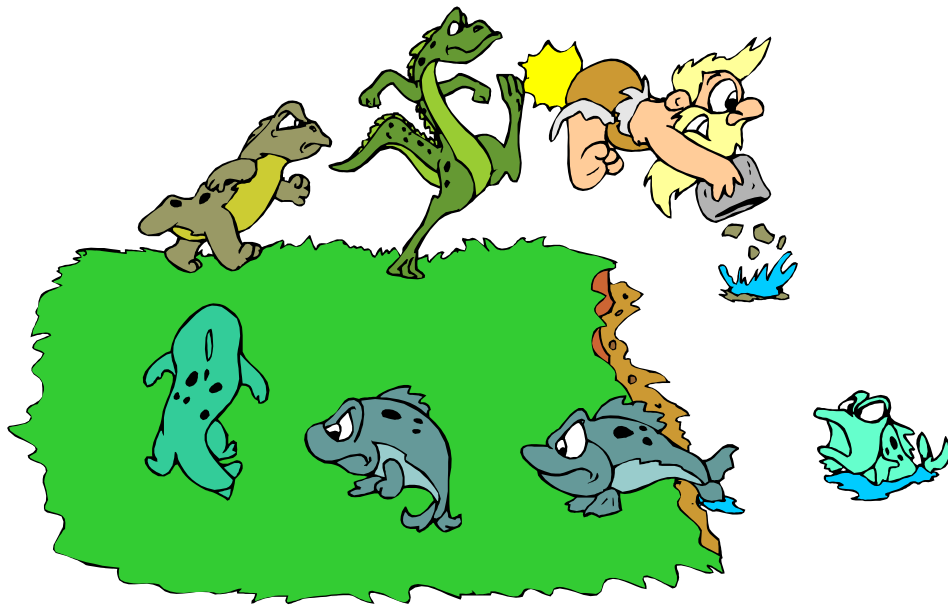
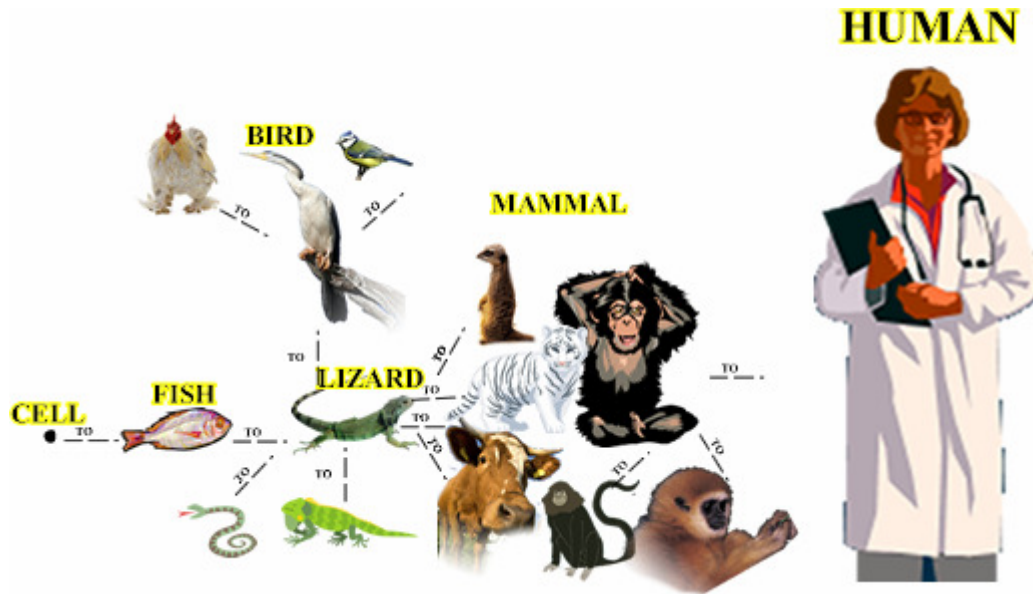
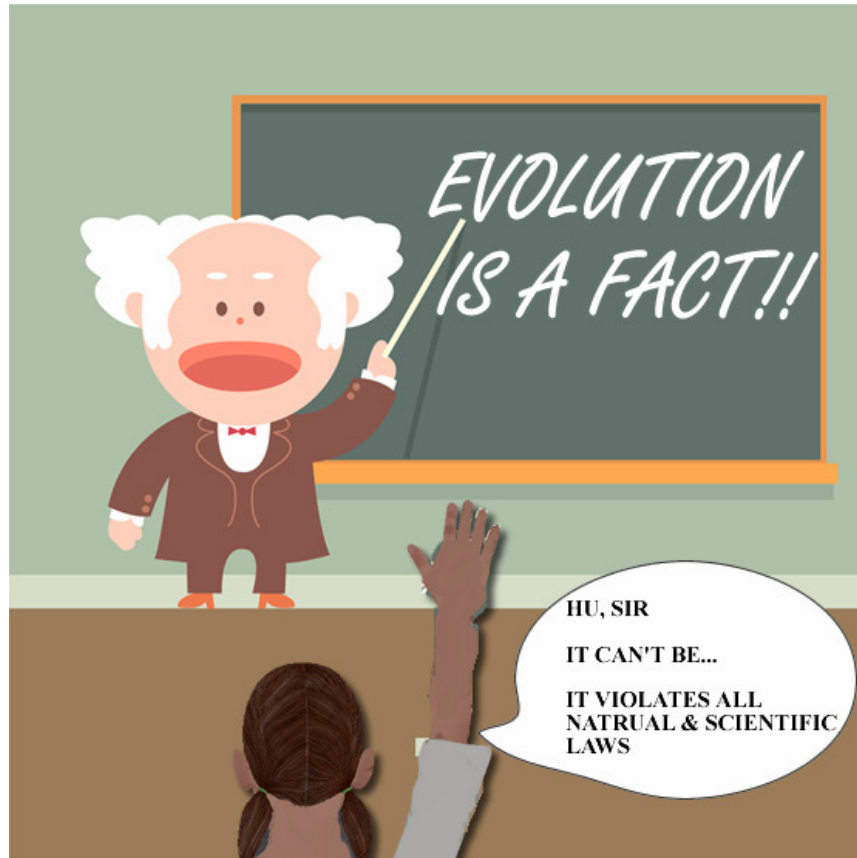


WHAT IS EVOLUTION & WHAT DOES IT BELIEVE?





Evolution is a theory propagated by a man named **Sir Charles Darwin**. He presented his theory in his book ‘**The Origin Of Species By Natural Selection**’. His theory was that the wide variety of life that we see today is due to a process of incremental steps, by mutations, over the course of millions of years, from initial source of life.



The Evolution Theory is being taught in many schools around the world as a fact, in spite of its violations of natural & scientific laws.

Below are 3 of the many natural laws that the Evolution Theory breaks:

- 1. 1st Law Of Thermodynamics**
- 2. 2nd Law of Thermodynamics**
- 3. The Law of Biogenesis**

The 1st Law Of Thermodynamics

The first law of thermodynamics states that matter can not be self-creating; ergo the idea promoted via the Evolution Theory that life mutates to better the species is false; this is because a mutation is not new matter being created but instead it is the corruption of already existing matter; in other words it is the second law of thermodynamics in action.

The 2nd Law Of Thermodynamics

The second Law of Thermodynamics states that matter deteriorates. If an organism mutates, the mutation is a corruption in the organism's system. A corruption in the system reduces the organism's level of advancement; in other words it no longer contains the necessary amount of information to keep its level of complexity. In order for information to evolve as Charles Darwin suggested it did, it would need to add information to its already existing information. The 2nd Law of Thermodynamics causes reduction in complexity by the taking away of information not the adding of information.

LAW OF BIOGENESIS

The Law of Biogenesis is played out at the birth of any organism. This law states that an organism can only

give birth to its own kind; (*dogs beget dogs, cats come from cats, etc.*) This is based on the way DNA works. The idea put forth from the Evolution Theory that an organism can change into another & different kind of organism is false because of its cells. There are millions of factors within the cell that prevent the change of species into other species. For one example, the cells in your DNA have little biological robots that correct problems, (*mutations*). Ergo if you take out the mutations you take out the chances of an organism's DNA coding, recoding into another animals DNA coding.



THE EVOLUTION THEORY: *AN ATHEIST'S ANSWER*

The Evolution Theory is commonly promoted by advocates of the Atheist religion as a way to advocate for the notion that there is no God. However, one thing that the Atheistic religion neglects to confront is the reality that Evolution starts off with all the necessary factors for life. It does not provide an adequate answer for how all the matter can into existence to pave the way for life to start.

Their best attempt to answer this question is their Big-Bang Theory. This theory suggests that all matter came spontaneously into existence via a big explosion. However in parallel the Big-Bang Theory assumes that there is matter and energy to already in existence to cause an explosion.
